


*Eph 4: 8-10*





*(Rediscovering the kingdom, 2010)*





they are most blessed.**




*Gen 13:5-6*

**Now Lot, who went with Abram, also had flocks, herds, and tents. And the land could not support both of them while living together, for their possessions were so great that they were not able to remain together.**




*Genesis 13:10-11*

*Genesis 19:25-27*



***Luke 17:20-23***





**Remember Lot's wife. Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it.**





**God has freedom for us. Our past can keep us in slavery, but Christ came to set us free from the yokes.**




**It is for FREEDOM Christ has set us free.**

**be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.**




**Freedom comes when we remember



# “TENACITY”


**Tenacity means being able to grip or hold something tightly. You have tenacity. You are called to grip these things the Lord is releasing today and host them well.**

**You are pillars of His kingdom!**




**“Tena” “city” Tena, latin, means “strong and healthy.”

“strong and healthy.”**


**Pillars of the Kingdom of God, strong, moving and
